

**AN ORDINANCE OF COUNCIL AMENDING, MODIFYING AND RE-ENACTING  
ARTICLE 772 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON,  
AS REVISED, REGARDING CITY SERVICE FEE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON, CABELL  
AND WAYNE COUNTIES, WEST VIRGINIA,** that Section Article 772 of the Codified  
Ordinances of the City of Huntington, as revised, are hereby **AMENDED, MODIFIED** and **RE-  
ENACTED** to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 772  
CITY SERVICE FEE**

.....  
**772.04 IMPOSITION OF CITY SERVICE FEE.**

(a) Effective ~~April 1, 2009~~ October 1, 2015, and thereafter, there is hereby imposed an  
increase in the City serve fee to help defray the cost of providing and maintaining City services within  
the City. The fee is hereby imposed upon any person who is employed within the City and meets the  
requirements of a user of municipal services as defined in Section 772.02(a) of this article. Such  
person or persons shall be required to pay a City service fee of ~~three~~ five dollars (\$~~35.00~~ 35.00) per calendar  
week.

(b) The Director of the Division of Finance shall place all fees collected under this article  
in a separate account.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that Section 772.04 shall become effective upon its  
adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that all other sections and sub-sections of Article 772 of  
the Codified Ordinances of the City of Huntington, as revised, shall remain in full force and effect  
until further Ordinance of this Council.
