

HAL GREER BOULEVARD COMPLETE STREET PROJECT

TWO-WAY SEPARATED BIKE LANE



As part of the Hal Greer Boulevard Complete Street Project, a protected, two-way separated bike lane will be installed between 3rd Ave. and 7th Ave. These lanes are physically separated from vehicle traffic and sidewalks by a median and in certain locations, on-street parking, creating a safe and convenient way for people to travel Hal Greer via bicycle to reach their destinations. This type of bicycle facility improves safety and comfort for all ages and levels of cyclist, allowing more people to utilize bicycling for short trips.
