Traffic patterns change on Hal Greer Boulevard from Sixth Avenue to Ninth Avenue, and Washington Boulevard beginning 7 a.m. Monday, June 5, 2023

Drivers can expect a shift in the traffic pattern along Hal Greer Boulevard from Sixth Avenue to Ninth Avenue beginning Monday, June 5, 2023, as contractors continue working in the 16th Street viaduct. The existing inside northbound lane of Hal Greer Boulevard will be closed, and all southbound traffic shifted to the right lane of Hal Greer Boulevard. This also will include work on the medians along Washington Boulevard and Hal Greer Boulevard. The west and east inside turning lanes will be shifted to the right to allow the contractor to complete the work.

Street parking will be removed from Third Avenue to Ninth Avenue on Hal Greer Boulevard.

Please use caution when adjusting to new traffic patterns. <u>Travelers should expect</u> the pattern change to take several days to set up and should not use areas between cones for turning.

Work is part of the Hal Greer Boulevard Corridor Project. Although crews are not always on-site, this is a permanent construction zone until the project is complete.

Traffic traveling through the area should pay attention to posted signs and message boards for current traffic patterns.

Drivers should expect delays, adjust their commuting schedules, and avoid the area if possible.

Please use caution when traveling through the area for flaggers, equipment, and workers.
