Drivers can expect a shift in the traffic pattern along Hal Greer Boulevard from Third Avenue to Washington Boulevard beginning at 7 a.m. Monday, July 17, as contractors install temporary traffic signals. It will take a few days to set up the traffic pattern change.

Northbound traffic will shift to the outside lane of Hal Greer Boulevard, and southbound traffic will shift to the median turn lane. This will allow the contractor to work on sidewalk, curb and gutter improvements on the northbound and southbound sides of Hal Greer Boulevard.

This work is part of the Hal Greer Boulevard Complete Street Project. Although crews are not always on site, this is a permanent construction zone until the project is complete.

The Hal Greer Boulevard Complete Street project's goal is to improve connectivity and safety for all modes of transportation on Hal Greer Boulevard from Third Avenue to the entrance to Kinetic Park on WV 10 and transform the corridor into a welcoming gateway and community asset.

Traffic traveling through the area should pay attention to posted signs and message boards for current traffic patterns. Drivers should expect delays and adjust their commuting schedules.

Please use caution when traveling through the area for flaggers, equipment and workers.
