Project SHINE is a housing rehabilitation program through the City of Huntington designed to provide assistance with minor exterior repairs. Participants eligible to apply must be the owner of and live in a home within city limits, be income eligible, and current on municipal and refuse fees. The City of Huntington partners with a variety of home repair volunteer organization and contractors, based on the specific repair needs of the approved applicants.

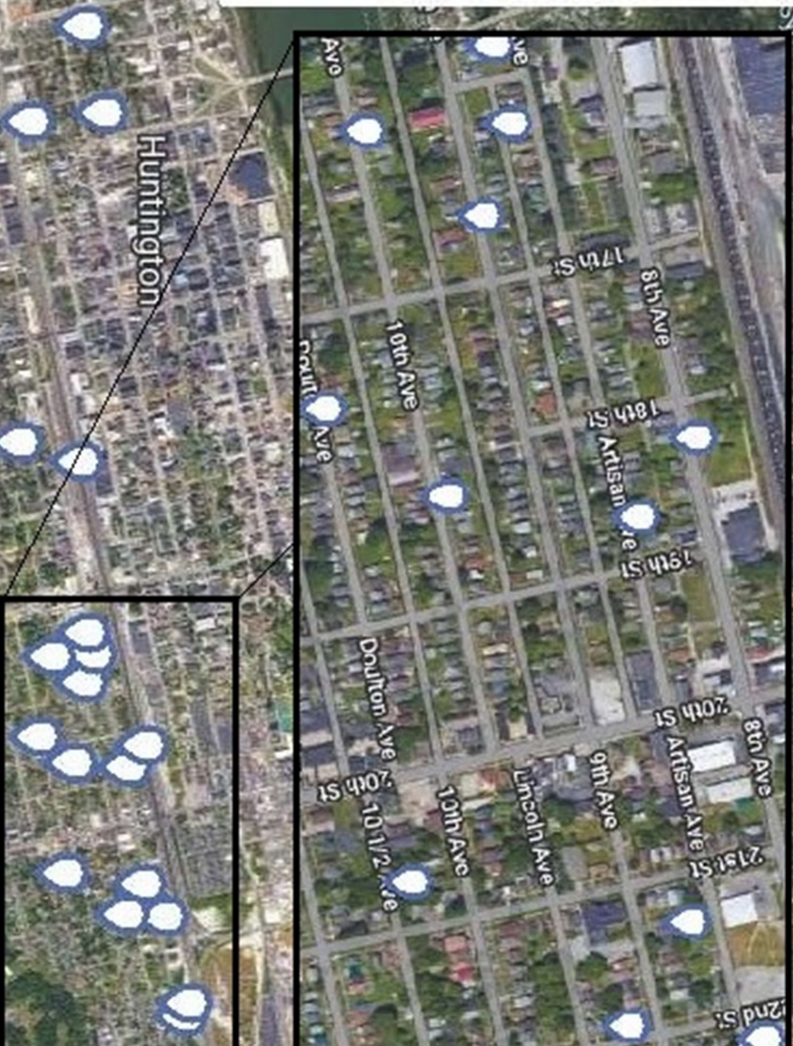
