Notice and Service Process	Notice of all hearings before the Commission will be published no later than Fifteen (15) days prior to the hearing as a Class I Legal Advertisement
	• The Planning Staff will provide notice to all property owners within a Four Hundred (400) foot radius no later than Fifteen (15) days before the hearing
Hearing	Regularly scheduled hearings will commence on the <u>First Monday of the month at 5:30 p.m.</u>
	The hearings shall be held in the City Council Chambers and it will be recorded and documented
	• It is the petitioner's responsibility to attend (or send a representative) to the scheduled meeting to present and to answer any questions regarding the request.
Decision	The Commission will make either a favorable or unfavorable recommendation to City Council
	The petition will then go before City Council for a first and second reading at their regularly scheduled times, which the petitioner may attend or send a representative to answer any questions.
	After City Council has heard the request, the applicant will be formally notified of the decision
Filing Fees	For each petition, a fee of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) shall be paid, the receipt of which shall accompany the petition.
