Rain Barrel Installation

DIVERTER AND PARTS KIT



Kit comes with gaskets, hose, diverter, spigot, and drill bits. You will need a drill for this project.



Tips for Installation

Rain Barrel must be on flat ground. You can use pavers, concrete blocks, or make a stand for your barrel.

Most rain barrels hold 55 gallons of water - this is about 440 pounds.

Water from rain barrel should not be used for drinking or cooking.

Barrels are made to hold liquid. Do not use trash can or other device as they are not water tight.

Adapter kits make rain barrel a closed system. Mosquitoes should not be able to breed.

If you do not use the water in your barrel within a month, you can release the water when there has been no rain.

You can water plants, wash car, or hold back rain for when the soil is not saturated and release water later.
